
## Metropolitan Utilities District

- Billing agent for sewer use and in some cases trash fees as a cost-saving measure to municipalities










## **Water Quality**

## M.U.D. meets or exceeds all state and federal standards.

- Lead is not present in our raw water, the finished water that leaves our plants, or in the water mains
- Plumbing materials
- Non-corrosive water to prevent leaching







## Health Effects of Lead Service Lines

- Permanent reduction in cognitive ability
- Hyperactivity
- Decreased IQ and attention span
- Increased risk of adverse health effects
- Increased risk of heart disease, high blood pressure, kidney, or nervous system
- Pregnant women, infants, and children are the most affected
