- Work is anticipated to be completed the first week of August 2024, barring any unplanned delays.
- Crew started on the west end and is working their way east.
- Traffic control is in place and parking is restricted on the south side of Farnam from 37th to Turner Blvd.
- The entrance/exit to Turner Park (31st Ave) will have a lane restriction. Anticipated start week of July 15.
- Some street and sidewalk repairs have been completed by the city.
- Some excavations remain due to continued necessary work.
- The crew continues to maintain all driveway access during the work.
- Because gas mains are being relocated, services are and will need replaced and/or reconnected in the area. Any inside gas meters may be moved to the outside. A technician from M.U.D. will work with the customers needing gas service work. This reconnection work includes additional holes near the buildings and possibly in Farnam after the new main has been installed.
- All work and dates are approximate and barring any unplanned delays.
